Observations


Exterior


District staff and/or Vision 202 participants identified the following positive **exterior** features of Lisle High School:

- The attractive and secure main entrance
- Main entrance is easily identifiable
- Ample parking capacity

The following challenges were also noted for the Lisle High School **exterior** and/or site grounds:

- Parking lot repairs are needed
- 2 Lack of athletic fields on campus
- Lack of windows & natural light in some classrooms





Observations

Interior

We are proud of the inviting entry and recent updates at Lisle High School.

District staff and/or Vision 202 participants identified the following positive **interior** features of Lisle High School:

- Learning Resource Center (LRC) Remodel
- The Auditorium, Commons Area, & Two Gyms
- The building has a nice "flow" or layout

The following challenges were also noted for the Lisle High School building **interior**:

- 1 High noise levels due to thin walls
- 2 Stairwells are not easily found
- 3 Inflexible furniture limits collaboration and group work
- Few integrated common areas including the appropriate tools to support collaboration
- 5 Limited faculty washrooms
- 6 Storage issues
- Small room size for some classes
- 8 Additional safety features in Science Labs
